Speak better English using the CONDITIONALS (IF)

- 1. Zero Conditional (General truths or scientific facts)
- How is it formed?
 If + present simple, + present simple.
- Examples:
 - If you heat water to 100°C, it boils.
 - o If it rains, the grass gets wet.
 - o If you mix red and yellow, you get orange.
 - 2. First Conditional (Real and possible situations in the future)
- How is it formed?If + present simple, + will + base verb.
- Examples:
 - o If it rains tomorrow, we will stay inside.
 - o If I study hard, I will pass the exam.
 - If they leave now, they will catch the train.

- 3. Second Conditional (Unreal, hypothetical situations in the present or future)
- How is it formed?
 If + past simple, + would + base verb.
- Examples:
 - If I were rich, I would travel the world.
 - If she studied more, she would pass the test.
 - If they lived closer, we would visit them more often.
 - **4.** Third Conditional (Situations that are impossible because they refer to the past)
- How is it formed?If + past perfect, + would have + past participle.
- Examples:
 - If I had known about the party, I would have gone.
 - If she had studied harder, she would have passed the exam.
 - If they had left earlier, they would have caught the flight.
 - 5. Mixed Conditional 1 (Past condition with present result)
- How is it formed?If + past perfect, + would + base verb.
- Examples:
 - If I had known about the meeting, I would be there now.
 - If he had taken the job, he would live in New York now.

- If we had studied harder, we would understand the lesson better now.
- 6. Mixed Conditional 2 (Present condition with past result)
- How is it formed?
 If + past simple, + would have + past participle.
- Examples:
 - If she were more organized, she would have completed the project on time.
 - If I were more confident, I would have spoken at the meeting yesterday.
 - If they didn't argue, they would have enjoyed their trip more.

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
